Purpose of the Student Resource Scheme

In accordance with the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006, the cost of providing instruction, administration and facilities for the education of students enrolled at State schools, who are Australian citizens or permanent residents, or children of Australian citizens or permanent residents, is met by the State.

Parents/carers are directly responsible for providing textbooks and other personal resources for their children while attending school. In recognition that these costs can be high, our School operates a Student Resource Scheme (SRS) that enables a parent/carer to enter into an agreement with the School that, for a specified annual participation fee,

provides resources and/or the purchase of many consumables and materials for the student.

The scheme is not used to raise funds for any other purpose than to provide resources for your child. Participation fees are directly applied to fund the services delivered by the scheme.

The Student Resource Scheme includes textbooks and/or educational resources that, in the absence of the scheme, would normally be purchased by the parent for the student to use at school. The scheme also includes printed material such as workbooks and worksheets, produced by the school in lieu of prescribed textbooks and online subscriptions.

Benefits of the Scheme

- Students have the required resources for their education when they commence school.
- The benefits from the savings that the school can secure through bulk purchases and discounts are passed on to families.
- The scheme saves parents/carers time and money in sourcing appropriate textbooks, stationery resources, Enrichment resources and other materials supplied under the scheme.

Student Resource Scheme (SRS) - Terms and Conditions

Participation in the scheme is voluntary. A parent's/carer's decision to participate is based on consideration of the value afforded by the scheme. If a parent chooses to participate in the scheme and completes the Participation Agreement Form, a fee will be due and payable. **Participation is for the duration of your child's enrolment at the school.** A parent can opt in or out of the scheme in subsequent years by completing another Participation Agreement. (available from the office).

On lodgement of the completed Participation Agreement Form, the School will provide the items to the student for use.

Payment of the participation fee by the parent is a requirement for continued participation in the scheme. Any unpaid invoices, will be managed according to the department's Debt Management Procedure and may result in the student being excluded from the scheme and/or from participating in non-curricular activities (e.g. camps, graduation celebrations) until payment is made

A parent/carer who does not wish to join the scheme is responsible for providing the student with the items that would otherwise have been provided to the student by the scheme to enable them to engage with the curriculum, this includes online subscriptions: see Terms and Conditions on the back page of the SRS Participation Agreement form, Paragraph 15

If you choose to opt out of the SRS you are still required to complete and return the Participation Agreement form.

The Student Resource Scheme does not include:

- voluntary financial contributions to supplement the instruction, administration and facilities for the education of the student at school
- student internet access during class time
- resources funded by the state through grant funding to provide a core educational service
- optional school activities such as excursions, camps, performances, Enrichment, Year 6 Shirt and Graduation.

Type of Resources Provided

Generally, the three types of resources that could be included are:

- **Owned** – these items are retained by the student and used as required (e.g. stationery, exercise books, student diary).
- **Used** – these items are used/consumed in class by the student (e.g. industry technology/cooking/art supplies).
⇒ work/items produced from these resources will remain the property of the student.
- **Hired** – these items are hired to the student for their personal use for a specific period of time (e.g. textbooks, musical instruments, laptops).
⇒ Hired items must be returned to the school in good condition at the end of the hire period or if the student leaves the school.
⇒ A repair or replacement cost may be charged to the parent for any hired items that are damaged or not returned.

Payment Options

SRS	SRS invoices will be issued in 2024. You can pay now as a credit on your account OR Make payment within the first week of commencing school in 2024

- Centrepay Deductions are available to pay the SRS fees. Use Centrepay to make regular deductions from your Centrelink payment.
