In 2025 Isabella State School will once again be offering parents a **Student Resource Scheme (SRS)**. The SRS is organised by the school; operates under the policy and guidelines of the Department of Education and Training (DET); is approved annually and endorsed by the P&C Association. ***In 2025, the school has been able to combine the booklist and all other costs for families into one SRS payment. In the following pages, you will see the comparison of costs between this year and the previous year.***

SRS is a requirement for all students

Participation in the Student Resource scheme (SRS) is optional. Please read the Terms and Conditions on page 2.

A parent/carer who does not wish to join the scheme is responsible for providing the student with the items that would otherwise have been provided to the student by the scheme to enable them to engage with the curriculum, this includes online subscriptions. Please note that the school purchases online subscriptions and stationery resources in bulk at a discount cost. The resources in the stationery list are of a high branded quality as requested by classroom teachers.

Purpose of the Student Resource Scheme

In accordance with the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006, the cost of providing instruction, administration and facilities for the education of students enrolled at State schools, who are Australian citizens or permanent residents, or children of Australian citizens or permanent residents, is met by the State.

Parents/carers are directly responsible for providing textbooks and other personal resources for their children while attending school. In recognition that these costs can be high, our School operates a Student Resource Scheme (SRS) that enables a parent/carer to enter into an agreement with the school that, for a specified annual participation fee, provides resources and/or the purchase of many consumables and materials for the student.

The scheme is not used to raise funds for any other purpose than to provide resources for your child. Participation fees are directly applied to fund the services delivered by the scheme.

The Student Resource Scheme includes textbooks and/or educational resources that, in the absence of the scheme, would normally be purchased by the parent for the student to use at school. The scheme also includes printed material such as workbooks and worksheets, produced by the school in lieu of prescribed textbooks and online subscriptions.

Student Resource Scheme (SRS) - Terms and Conditions

Participation in the scheme is voluntary. A parent's/carer's decision to participate is based on consideration of the value afforded by the scheme. If a parent chooses to participate in the scheme and completes the Participation Agreement Form, a fee will be due and payable. **Participation Agreement is for the duration of your child's enrolment at the school.** A parent can opt in or out of the scheme in subsequent years by completing another Participation Agreement. (Available from the office).

Payment of the participation fee by the parent is a requirement for continued participation in the scheme. Any unpaid invoices, will be managed according to the department's Debt Management Procedure and may result in the student being excluded from the scheme and/or from participating in non-curricular activities (e.g., camps, graduation celebrations) until payment is made
